

ORDINANCE 2008-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MONTVERDE, FLORIDA, REPEALING ORDINANCE 3-7-88 WHICH SUBJECTED ANY CHECK RETURNED FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS OR OTHERWISE UNCOLLECTIBLE TO A SERVICE FEE, AND THAT FURTHER PROVIDED FOR PAYMENT AND COLLECTION OF THE SERVICE FEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 3-7-88 implemented a service fee of \$10.00 for any check returned to the Town for insufficient funds or that was otherwise uncollectible;

WHEREAS, it further provided for means of collecting the service fee;

WHEREAS, service fees charged on return checks are currently enforced by the rules set forth in §166.251, *Florida Statutes* which provides for an amount greater than as set forth in Ordinance 3-7-88;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it desires to repeal Ordinance 3-7-88; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance has been advertised as required by law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MONTVERDE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and, by this reference, are hereby incorporated into and made an integral part of this ordinance.

Section 2. Repeal. Ordinance 3-7-88 is **REPEALED**.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

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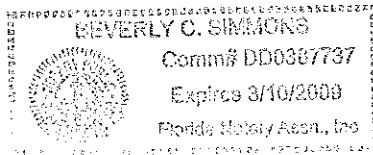
